 - ❑ Two computers with high end graphics for use by students and faculty with the ARTstor Digital Library
 - ❑ A laptop computer for use in library instruction
 - ❑ Wireless computer mice

- The ARTstor annual access fee. The capital archive fee and one year of access were funded by a grant from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation. The annual cost to maintain access to this collection is \$5,000.
